## Agency History

Everett based and privately owned, Sunrise Services, Inc. began serving persons with developmental disabilities in small Congregate Care Facilities in 1977. In 1989, Sunrise Home Care Agency (SHCA) became licensed through the Washington State Department of Health to augment programs for persons with developmental disabilities living in their own homes by providing them with a wider range of personal care services.

SHCA expanded services to the elderly, disabled children, and persons with other disabilities through the provision of Medicaid Personal Care Services, COPEs, In-Home Respite Services and Private Care Services. Expansion of in-home services continued and care is now provided in Snohomish, Island, Skagit and Whatcom counties.

In 1997, SHCA again met community needs through the development of the **Caregiver Training Program** and became a major trainer of caregivers for home care agencies, adult family homes, boarding homes, and other community caregivers issuing certificates of completion for Revised Fundamentals of Caregiving Training, Revised Modified Fundamentals of Caregiving Training, Nurse Delegation, CPR / First Aid, Continuing Education and so much more. The Educational Center for Care Professionals opened June, 2002, due to the overwhelming success of Sunrise Home Care Agency's Training Program. The Educational Center is a three-classroom facility with a complete caregiving laboratory for hands-on instruction.

SHCA developed Washington's first Enhanced Home Services (EHS) program in 1998 and was recognized by Governor Locke for our innovation in improving the in-home services to our seniors and the disabled.

Sunrise Home Health Agency received its license in XXXX so we could develop **Nurse Delegation** services. Nurse delegation provides a safety net of supervision and instruction for the provision of skilled care by home care aides for clients living in their community home. We welcomed the 2009 expansion of nurse delegation to include insulin injections for those who are experiencing diabetes.

Sunrise Home Care Agency continues today to seek excellence in services that will enable persons at risk to stay at home safely and comfortably. We actively seek new opportunities to meet the needs of our communities and welcome your ideas and suggestions.
